TASTING NOTES:

Bringing together two of its most renowned varieties Bonarda and Malbec, this blend boasts an elegant touch of violet, flavors of ripe strawberries, and soft, yet persistent, structure.

AGING:

Both Bonarda and Malbec are aged individually for six months on 3-year-old French Oak Barrels and then blended together to age for a minimum of six additional months in bottle.
